

CJCP has a dress code policy to help create a safe and orderly environment, instill discipline, and eliminate the competition and distractions caused by varied dress styles. You will be expected to arrive in dress code every day. Please cooperate, display modesty and neatness, and take pride in these clean, neat and attractive uniforms. We rely on your common sense and your parents' and/or guardians' support in helping maintain this dress code.

PLEASE NOTE...

If you arrive at school out of uniform,
your parents will be called.

If you are unable to obtain the proper uniform you shall receive
consequences per the code of conduct.

<i>UNIFORM FOR GIRLS</i>	<i>UNIFORM FOR BOYS</i>
<p>Shirts: Light Blue (Middle School) Navy Blue (High School) these shirts may be purchased at the school.</p> <p>Any shirt worn outside of those sold at the school will result in a uniform violation. (The collars of the shirts will be indicators of students being in FULL uniform)</p> <p>(T-Shirts are only permitted in Gym)</p> <p>* ALL SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN AT ALL TIMES *</p>	
<p>Stockings or Socks: Plain White, Navy, or Black stockings are acceptable. Lace or fishnet stockings are NOT permitted.</p> <p>NO DESIGNS or PATTERNS</p> <p>Shoes: Brown or Black Only (1 color)</p>	<p>Socks: White, Navy, or Black NO DESIGNS or PATTERNS</p> <p>Shoes: Black or Brown (1 color)</p>
<p>Acceptable Sweaters: Navy blue sweater vest, pull over, v-necked, or cardigan.</p> <p>***SWEATERS ARE NOT TO HAVE HOODS or LOGOS. SCHOOL SWEATSHIRTS OR FLEECE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS PART OF THE UNIFORM***.</p>	

Uniforms:

- ALL shirts MUST be purchased from the school. The white oxford shirts are NO LONGER an option and any other shirt not purchased from CJCPCS will be considered a violation of the dress code.**
- BOOTS OF ANY KIND OR STYLE ARE NO LONGER PERMITTED. (THIS IS INCLUSIVE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO UGGS & TIMBERLAND).**
- Moccasins or any other shoe that resemble a slipper are NOT permitted.
- SKIRTS ARE NO LONGER PART OF THE SCHOOL UNIFORM** and students arriving in a skirt will be sent home immediately or a change of clothes must be brought to school.
- If a student arrives to school out of uniform they will automatically receive consequences per the school's code of conduct.

6. ALL tights and socks must be plain white, navy, or black. This will be strictly enforced this year.
7. ALL shoes are to be plain (one color). Two-toned shoes will NOT be considered uniform and will result in a uniform violation.
8. School sweaters are NOT to have a hood. (Sweatshirts, Fleece, or Hoodies are NOT allowed)
9. ALL school sweaters are to be a solid navy blue
10. **Tapered/Fitted/"Skinny"/Skin-Tight uniform pants are NOT allowed for GIRLS or BOYS.**

Gym Uniform: (MANDATORY & Available at CJPCPS September 2011)

1. Navy blue school logo sweats and t-shirt (Middle School)
2. Sport Gray school logo sweats and t-shirt (High School)
3. **PLEASE NOTE:** Students will not be allowed to participate in gym without their gym uniform and will receive a zero for participation for the day.

Physical Appearance:

1. School I.D **MUST BE WORN** at **ALL** times.
2. NO facial or visible body piercing. Please remove them before school starts.
3. Male students are not permitted to wear earrings during the school day, (unless you have a dress down pass). Any male student who decides to obtain an ear piercing during the school year will be expected to remove earrings during school hours. *This is not optional nor is it up for discussion.
4. ALL tattoos must be covered at ALL TIMES, NO EXCUSES.
5. Shirts must be tucked in at ALL times.
6. Pants must be at the natural waistline, NO EXCUSES.
7. Belts are to be worn daily and considered as part of the uniform.
8. NO excessive dying of the hair.
9. Even on dress down day shirts must be full length, not form fitting, and cover the chest and shoulders and fitting across the shoulders.
10. Leggings/Jeggings or any other pants that resemble them are NOT to be worn to school at all, **EVEN ON DRESS DOWN DAY.**
11. **THERMAL AND UNDER ARMOR ARE NOT PERMITTED UNDER UNIFORM SHIRTS. PLEASE PURCHASE A SCHOOL SWEATER or LONG SLEEVED SHIRT.**
12. Reminder: WE DRESS UP, NOT DRESS DOWN or are in FULL school uniform on field trips, unless otherwise arranged with the Dean and/or CEO.

Outerwear:

1. Outerwear, such as windbreakers, jean jackets, hoods, coats, or ski jackets, may NOT be worn during school hours.
